Compete up or down an age level.



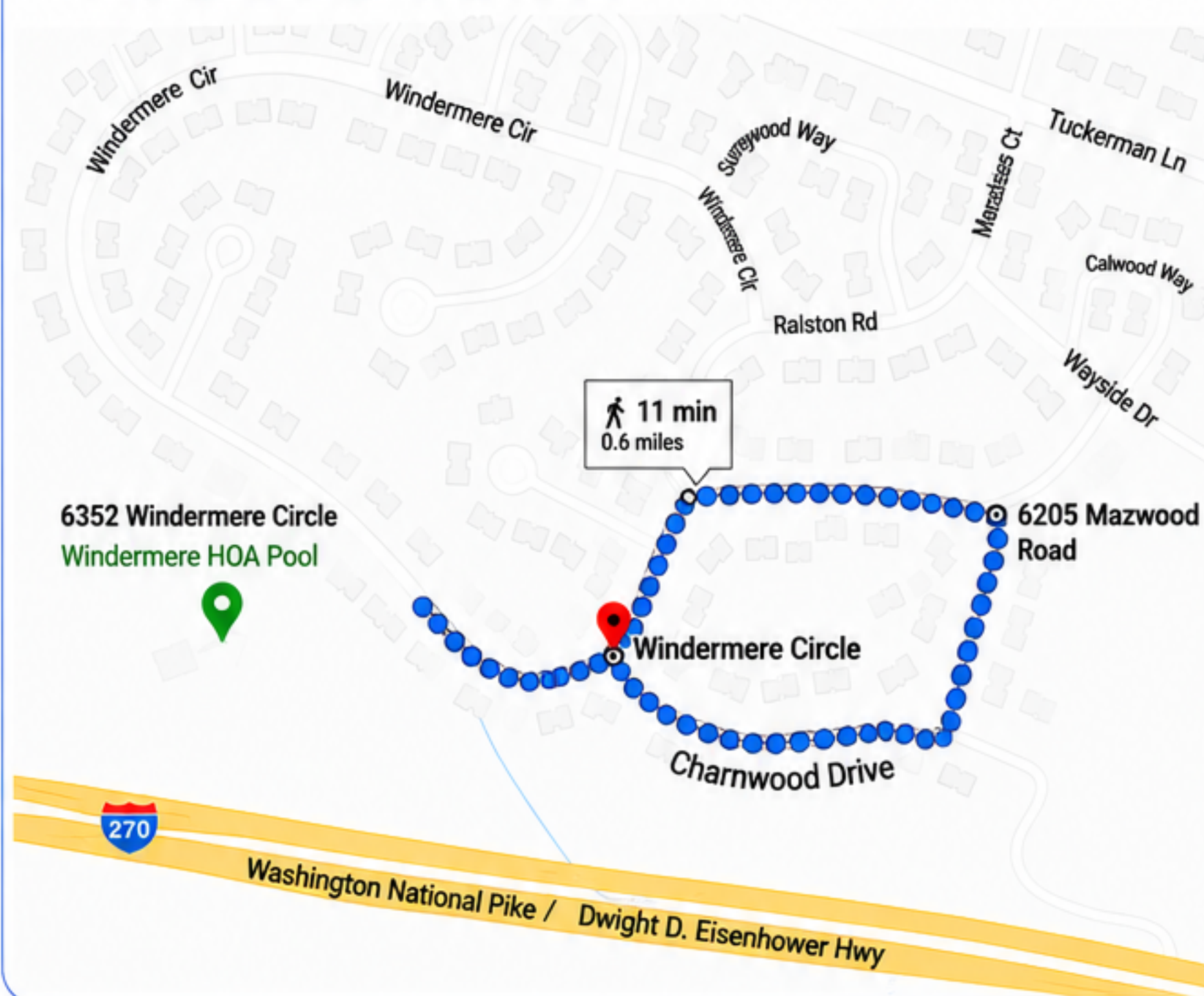
